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

Well, there are two trains of thought going on right here. And I want to address both of them helped me make sure we stay on track here. All right, because there's a lot to talk about here. The first one is the shame and guilt. All right, yeah. The second one is the nature of our fantasies relative to what's available to us in reality. Okay, so the first one is about the shame and guilt. Listen, a lot of that surrounds porn. And that's exactly the trail we're going to go down in the second point, which is why this is a related pair of topics. Most of the guys who come to me who struggle with sexual fantasy, and indeed with porn usage are men of faith. And I went to a very well traveled men's group on Facebook, where a guy had started a thread saying, Hey, we're going to teach high school boys in Sunday school this weekend, how to avoid porn, and I've got a great idea. I'm going to show them a video of a man eating a steak. 30 seconds, you noticed him eating a T bone. And at the end, I'm gonna go Hey, guys, do you feel satisfied? Are you still hungry? Was that really fulfilling to you? And I'm thinking to myself Wowzers, right. And I come from a Judeo Christian background. I've taught Sunday school. I've been in the Sunday School quote, unquote, classes where they tell girls hey, here's a penis, stay away from it. I've been there. I've seen it. I've heard about it. It's always the same. The kids are all excited about it. And then of course, it isn't very exciting. It stigmatizes the shame and guilt more than anything else. So back to the men's group here on Facebook, all the guys who are in this Opie's echo chamber or like yeah, right on show those guys and I'm like, Oh, you guys and sliders as if you've never been a teenager before, or you're all demisexual or asexual and the sounds reasonable to you. And, you know, I've been at this a long time, I've decided what I believe and I can defend it. So against my better judgment, I responded to the thread very, very politely I said, Hey, just make sure you prepare yourself. For the smart ask you to raises his hand and goes so what you're trying to tell me is instead of watching a guy eat the steak, I should go out and bang as many chicks as I can right now, so that I can actually be full and satisfied, right? And then what happens is, when we can't have those women were horny for, we start disliking and resenting those women. And that's where you get the red pill, guys, that's where you get the MiG tau guys, this division between men and women, which they'll blame on porn. But really, it's on our shame and guilt where the blame falls. And then ultimately, what ends up happening is we start feeling resentment and probably deep disdain and whatever negative emotion you want to ascribe to it towards the God of the universe himself or putting us in this position and creating us this way. And I just don't see anything good that comes from it. Now, no, in our world we live in today, Adolescence is prolonged. And indeed, We have people who are deciding they aren't going to get married anymore. A lot of people are shunning the idea of a higher power and religious ethics and this, that and the other. So I know it leaves us in a place where I'm not sure there are easy answers. But let's get to the second part of this discussion. You get on the aforementioned porn, and you look at what's really, really popular, and contrary to the angry women and other people who are against porn, having never watched it before. It's all these things that we would really kind of be ashamed to admit we want to do in real life. And yet, they're really, really popular. So if you're a person who comes from a very dogmatic image regarding the sex, you're not allowed to have, not even ever, I mean, the only sex you're going to be limited to for the rest of your life apparently is a monogamous relationship with one wife, or else God doesn't like you anymore. You know, whether you believe that's the gospel truth or not, that's what's ingrained in a lot of us. And that not only foments the shame and guilt within us, what makes it fester is when we are doing that which we find to be sinful. You know, watching people have sex, lusting after women, or whatever the way our imaginations spin, and the direction our imagination goes in, just heaped shame and guilt back onto it. Now, here's the punchline, universally, these are the most popular genres, and more and more women are starting to watch it. You know, it used to be more women would read romance novels, then watch porn, and then they get angry at men for wanting to see naked chicks. And now based on the latest studies I've seen in the year 2022, more women are watching porn than reading romance novels. I mean, you know, 50 Shades of Grey, the star rose and the star faded, right? I mean, you know, that was a phenomenon. And there's also more quote unquote, woman friendly porn, which is still depraved a lot of times. But isn't it time we really, at the very least, and this is independent of our religious views, really our worldview in general?
