Moving on to episode number two, now it's time to play a clip for you that proves that well, this show has been a little bit different all along. It's not about taking advantage of women. It's not really about tips, tricks and tactics, or certainly luring women into bed. It's about long term relationships and being a great man who attracts the right kind of woman. Now, that sounds obvious to you in the year 2022 or beyond, if you're listening to this show later, it wasn't so obvious back then the pickup artists movement, or the underground Pua community as they

call themselves, the seduction community was another name for it really was all about this kind of dark art of attracting and seducing women, a lot of times specifically for the purpose of simply getting laid.
