Let's say you're already dating a woman, you met her some time before Halloween, and either you met her online, you've had coffee with her, let me tell you something that's golden that I have direct experience with, invite her over to your place on Halloween to help you hand out candy to the kids. Now, I'll tell you why this is golden.
